Central Coast Council is preparing to deliver one of the region's most significant infrastructure projects – a nine kilometre water pipeline from Mardi to Warnervale. As part of the development of this project we've been speaking with the community to ensure that the community is informed about the projects benefits and potential impacts. During the first phase of engagement, the community were provided with information on the project and were also invited to speak directly with the M2WP project team.

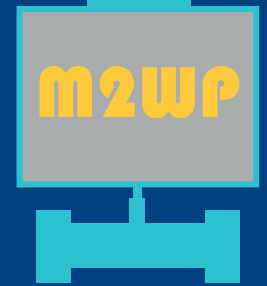

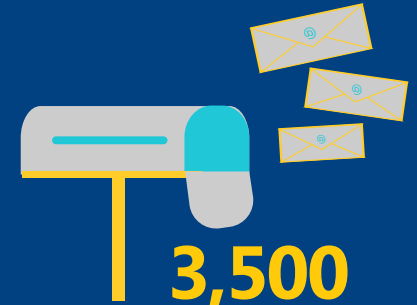
