

Central Coast parking survey

Engagement Summary

Between 7 November and 9 December 2018 Central Coast Council ran a community survey to better understand parking issues in key focus areas across the region and collect feedback on potential solutions for the development of a Central Coast Regional Parking Strategy.

The key focus areas of the survey were:

- Woy Woy
- Wyong
- Terrigal
- The Entrance
- Ourimbah
- Gosford City Centre
- Lisarow train station
- Tuggerah train station
- Warnervale train station

Feedback on other areas on the Central Coast was also welcomed.

All information collected about other areas will be used to help us develop overarching recommendations for the entire Central Coast region.

What's next?

Survey results will be analysed and this community feedback, along with technical studies, will be used to develop a draft strategy.

This draft strategy will be placed on public exhibition for further community feedback in 2019.

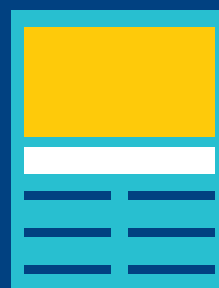

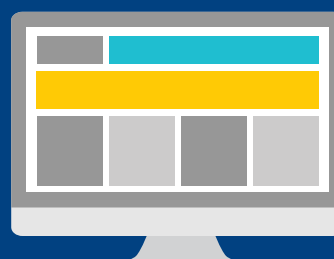
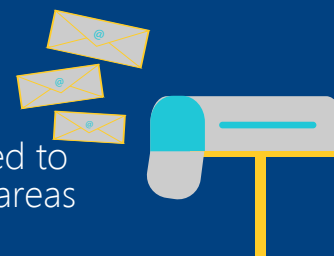
