

Let's Talk Terrigal Terrigal CBD traffic flow improvements

Engagement summary

We sought community feedback on Stage 1 and 2 of Terrigal CBD traffic flow improvements between 2 February and 9 March 2018 as part of a broader campaign, Let's talk Terrigal.

Let's Talk Terrigal provided the community with the opportunity to make submissions on proposed traffic flow improvements, and also learn about the upcoming Central Coast Parking Strategy, Terrigal rock pool restoration, Banjo's Skate Park and Rotary Park Playground upgrade.

We consulted the community on the traffic flow improvements to understand:

- What they believe the issues were
- The potential impacts of the design
- Potential alternatives to design elements.

Analysis of 136 submissions made by the community resulted in high level themes being identified for the traffic flow improvements:

- Traffic flow impacts
- Hudson Lane
- On-street parking
- Pedestrian crossings and safety
- Terrigal Esplanade traffic restrictions

More themes that emerged from consultation included parking, planning and investment in Terrigal and other local projects and issues.

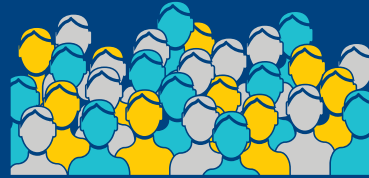
What next?

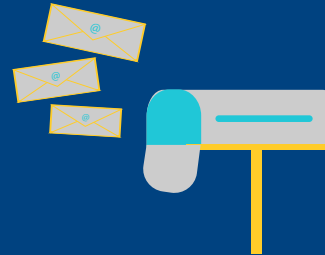
