

Draft Climate Change Policy

Engagement Summary

Between 4 February and 15 March 2019 Central Coast Council sought public comment on the Draft Climate Change Policy prior to being finalised and adopted. A preliminary survey was also carried out between 12 November and 7 December 2018.

The draft policy outlines broad actions on climate change and will enable Council to align its operations and strategic planning with the NSW State Climate Change Policy Framework.

It was made available to download at yourvoiceourcoast.com and a series of community workshops to discuss the draft policy were held in every ward – five in total – across the Coast.

What's next?

Council will amend the draft policy based on the submissions received, the analysed survey data and the community workshops. This finalised policy will be reported to Council to be endorsed.

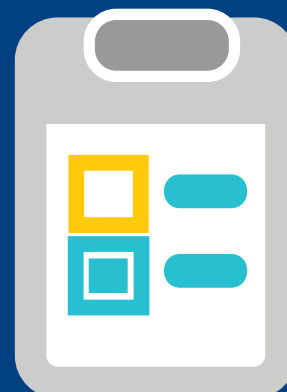
