

Winney Bay Cliff Top Walk

Engagement Summary

Following a resolution from the Ordinary Council Meeting held on 11 June 2018, Central Coast Council committed to re-exhibiting the Concept Plans for the Winney Bay Cliff Top Walk and encouraged the community to have their say on what this project could look like and what it could deliver for the Central Coast.

The community were asked to review the concept plans and provide their opinion on the project based on the opportunities and challenges identified for the project.

Engagement Results

53.2% of survey respondents were in support of the project, however 75.6% of the community are not supportive of the inclusion of Market Stall Sites. Further analysis of the completed surveys identified the following themes as priorities for the community:

- Achieving an inclusive walkway for all ages and abilities to use is important to the community.
- The environment should be considered during the construction of the project and the clearing of vegetation should be done so sparingly.
- Addressing the weed infestation and conducting bush regeneration should be an important deliverable for this project.

What next

Council will conduct further analysis of the survey responses and will provide a full consultation report to Councillors along with recommendations based off of the feedback received during the consultation period.

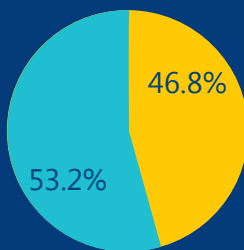
