

Susan Fahey Park playspace Round 2 consultation

Engagement summary

Between 4 and 20 March 2020 Central Coast Council sought community feedback on how to use the space at Susan Fahey Park reserve, Copacabana.

Following a round of community consultation that took place in September 2019, a concept design plan was developed for a district-sized playspace. However, additional feedback we received indicated a preference for the space to be used as an open area to kick a ball around in, rather than a district-sized playspace – which wasn't captured in our original consultation.

To understand the true representation of the local community's needs and progress this project, we provided a second opportunity for the community to have their say – by way of a vote:

- A district-sized playspace (concept design plans were provided) OR
- An open area to kick a ball around in.

This vote was available for all community members to complete on yourvoiceourcoast.com.

Results

In total, we received **196** unique votes:

- **60%** voted for a district-sized playspace
- **40%** voted for an open area to kick a ball around in

What's next?

We will be moving forward with constructing a district-sized playspace.

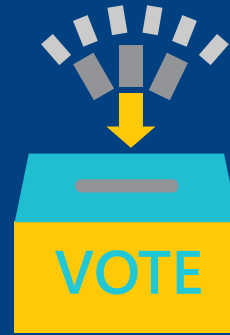
A few adjustments were made to the initial concept design plans following the second round of community consultation and the final plan can now be seen on yourvoiceourcoast.com.
