Summary

Between 15 August and 12 September 2022 Central Coast Council sought community feedback on the concept plans for the Norah Head Community Hall.

Plans to build a new community hall were outlined in the Masterplan for Norah Head Village 2017 with extensive community consultation in 2019. The Masterplan proposes to relocate existing amenities building and provide services for events.

The new community hall design includes a multifunctional hall, kitchen, accessible toilets, storage. The playground equipment from the current Norah Head Hall site will also be relocated and included.

We invited the community to submit questions about the proposal and provide feedback on the draft plans.

Engagement Results

Themes from the feedback included:

- Positioning of the building, playspace, kitchen, storage space and toilets
- Fencing should include the playspace
- Provision for solar should be included
- Shade and seating provisions for the playspace
