Plan of Management for Council Community Land Update

Engagement summary



Summary

Between 24 September 2024 and 25 November 2024, Central Coast Council sought community feedback on a Plan of Management (POM) to categorise or re-categorise Community Land. This was a continuation of the findings from an area-wide POM in 2023 that indicated 10% of the recategorised land from the original engagement should be reviewed in the future. This was then combined with 160 lots of land being re-categorised for the first time.

The community were invited to review the Land Schedule, Maps and Council Report to help identify and explain the reasoning behind the land being re-categorised. Council also held Public Hearings that allowed community members to learn more and provide direct feedback to an independent facilitator which was captured in a follow-up report.

Engagement Results

A total of 31 submissions were received via online submission form. In addition, there were 30 total attendees for 3 public hearings.

Following the feedback received during public exhibition, Council staff will review all submissions, finalise the Plan of Management and prepare a report on the outcome of the public exhibition process for Council's consideration.
